Furthermore, we expect all participants and attendees to acknowledge that every human being is equally valuable and that each individual's freedom ends where another individual's freedom begins.

We, the Youth of European Nationalities (YEN), are an independent youth organisation that was founded in 1984. We are proud to currently represent 41 member organisations from 18 different countries (as of January 2023). Our motto is: 'Minority Rights Are Human Rights'. We advocate for the interests of young members of Europe's autochthonous, linguistic and national minorities.

Every year we organise several activities for young people belonging to autochthonous, linguistic or national minorities. These events bring together young people from all over Europe to work intensively on current political and cultural issues affecting minorities in Europe. We want to create space for exchange, discovering commonalities and gathering knowledge, but also space for discussion and socialising - and above all for building friendships across national borders.
