"Minority Youth in the Spotlight"

Your feedback and ideas are the basis for planning our upcoming year. In 2025, we would like to specifically address the topics you mentioned. We hope you will enjoy the activities and look forward to seeing you there!

Visibility and the (in)ability to influence the perceptions that majority communities hold of minority communities are crucial for the identity of people from autochthonous, national, ethnic, and linguistic minorities. At YEN, we are committed to empowering and encouraging young people from these minorities to play an active role in shaping their identity, their image, and their approach to visibility."

So in 2025, our theme for the year is " Minority Youth in the Spotlight ".

Throughout the year, our seminars and training sessions will focus on the visibility and self-representation of Minority Youth within society. We want to explore the importance of visibility for young people from national, ethnic, and linguistic minorities. To do this, we will have a look on how minority communities are portrayed, both from within and by outside sources, and look at best practices for visibility actions within our network to gain awareness of our visibility and representation.

We will be particular focus on learning practical skills that can support your youth minority organisations and projects. You will have the chance to develop skills for effective self-expression - whether through video production, social media, art, or performance - enabling you to share your cultural creative expressions and stories and shape your own image in a safer environment of young people from national, ethnic, and linguistic minorities

Our goal this year is that you can exchange ideas, connect, and support each other in representing your identities authentically. We want our communities to be seen as we wish to be seen - free from stereotypes and reflected in our own voices. Together, we aim to foster visibility, cultural pride, and mutual respect, ensuring that each unique identity is recognised and valued within society.

In 2025, we reflect on the importance and impact of visibility and self-representation, deepen our knowledge for effective visibility actions, inspire one another through cultural exchange, and motivate each other to take active, self-determined steps to 'create and spread our own image' within society.

The topic of "Visibility" will be discussed primarily in the following seminars: The Easter Seminar, the Autumn Seminar, and the three "Visibility in Actio" n Trainings. All activities by YEN will use methodologies of non-formal education. We also invite you to take part in events organised by our partner organisations.

Visibility in Action Training 1: Video / Documentation 20th – 24th February 2025 | Berlin, Germany

Throughout the year, we will offer **three short training courses** - the **"Training series "Visibility in action"**. These trainings will focus on learning practical skills for Visibility actions. Each training will address a different skill in the topic of visibility and self-expression and its use in opportunities to widen the cause of minority youth organisations.

The trainings are aimed to essentially help and you and others, belonging to national, ethnic, and linguistic minorities and work in, or are interested in working in the field of visibility, with right skills. We want to encourage and motivate you to actively contribute to your organisation's visibility efforts and thereby support the self-representation of minority youth.

These trainings are predominantly for young people who are active in their Minority youth organisations. If you would like, you can participate in all three trainings, but you can also participate in just one or two - whatever suits you best.

Our year 2025 starts with the Visibility in Action Training 1: Video / Documenation. As a young person from an autochthonous, linguistic, national and/or ethnic minority, we want to support you in acquiring practical skills for visibility action within your youth organisations and projects. This training will help you acquire skills on how to conceptualise, film and cut videos and documentations of Minority (youth) events.

In more detail, you will:

- gain knowledge and skills about video-making and documenting of minority events.
- have the opportunity to share skills, hurdles and learning processes with a small group of young people from minority groups in Europe.
- be invited to apply your newly gained skills in YEN's visibility projects.

Easter Seminar "Visibility matters "

11th -17th April 2025 | Opole, Poland

Organised by YEN and BJDM (the German minority in Poland)

Our first major event of the year will take place in Opole, Poland and will be hosted by the youth organisation of the German minority in Poland called BJDM. . The topic of this workshop is "Visibility matters", with the aim to understand the impact and importance of being visible, of one's cultural identity. You will reflect on its value and be inspired to engage in self-representation and visibility work, that can benefit your community.

During the workshop you will:

- reflect and exchange on existing self- and external depictions of your minoritised communities and how they are affecting you and your communities.
- reflect on your multifaced identities with others and think about how they are connected to visibility and representation.
- reflect on how you can get active to impact the ways in which your community is portrayed in broader society
- exchange good practices of visibility work of your youth organisations.

Visibility in Action Training 2: Graphic design June | tbd

In the second training of the Visibility in Action series, we will focus on developing practical skills in graphic design. You will learn basic tools, tips, and tricks to create appealing designs for different target groups. These newly gained skills can be applied within your youth organisation and projects.

In more detail, you will:

- learn tips and tricks for designing visuals that can be used in your organisations or projects.
- incorporate cultural expressions from your minority community into your designs.
- have the opportunity to share your graphic design skills in a small group of young people from minority groups in Europe.
- apply your newly gained skills in YEN's visibility projects.

Autumn Seminar "Visibility through creativity" End September / Beginning of October | Daruvar, Croatia

Organised by YEN and the Czechs Minority in Croatia

Our last major event of the year will take place in Daruvar, Croatia, and will be organised by the Czechs Minority in Croatia. In the Autumn Seminar you are invited to spend a week full of creativity (theatre, sing and dances and creative writing) together. As a participant, you will take part in one of the several creative workshops, where you express your "minority identity" in your chosen creative form.

Throughout the workshop, you will:

- gain skills in one of the creative/artistic workshops (theatre, creative writing and singing and dancing) reflect on how you want to express yourself and your minority identity.
- create, together with other young people from minorities in Europe, a show or exhibition of your outcomes of the workshops
- gain interpersonal skills such as teamwork in diverse groups, presentation skills, and intercultural competencies.

Take part in this important event and meet around 30 other young people from different minorities across Europe! Join this inspiring experience and present yourself together in a creative way.



Visibility in Action Training 3: Creative action in the public sphere

"Following the Autumn Seminar, Visibility through Creativity, we plan to end the year with one final training in the Visibility in Action series: Creative action in the public sphere. As a person from an autochthonous, linguistic, national, and/or ethnic minority, you may know that visibility projects can often require substantial resources. This training will provide knowledge and strategies for carrying out alternative, low-cost visibility actions for your community, such as flash mobs.

In more detail, you will:

- familiarise yourself with the elements and various forms of creative actions.
- learn diverse creative methods for engaging in the public sphere.
- have the opportunity to share skills, hurdles and learning processes with a small group of young people from minority groups in Europe.

RISE UP: Revitalising Languages and Safeguarding Cultural Diversity

HIGA! is a summit of young speakers of minoritised languages. The aim of it is, is to promoting linguistic diversity and linguistic activism. It is much more than just a meeting, it is a space for collaboration, learning and action for young people committed to the revitalization of languages.

HIGA! offers practical trainings in language activism, showing effective tools and strategies to protect and revitalise languages. The programme encourages active participation and creative solutions to the challenges faced by linguistic minorities. It also boosts awareness of the social, political, and cultural issues affecting minority languages, equipping participants with a critical, hands-on approach to language advocacy.



Dikh He Na Bister

August 2025 | Krakow, Poland

DIKH HE NA BISTER ("Look and don't forget" in Romani) is the Roma Genocide Remembrance Initiative bringing together hundreds of young Roma and non-Roma from all over Europe each year. During one week young people take part in workshops and lectures facilitated by experts and activists in the field of the Roma Genocide, Holocaust, human rights education and youth activism. This aims to bridge the gap between the historic experience of the Roma Genocide and present concerns relating to far-right / neo-Nazi movements and tendencies within societies across Europe. The nature of the subject links participation to both human rights education and to the recognition of Roma identity.
